

PERFECT LOVE CAST OUT FEAR Lesson Four

I John 4:17-18 (NKJV) Scripture Lesson

Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world. There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment (punishment). But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.

Perfected love – Love brought to its intended goal.

"Perfect love is Jesus, God wrapped in human flesh. Perfect Love goes to any length to save and any height to reach. Perfect Love calls the prisoner His brother, redeems him and sets him free. Perfect Love is complete, all consuming, with no traces of doubt in the power of the Holy One. Perfect Love sets a glittering crown on the head of the orphan and calls her "Beloved Daughter."

A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

John 13:34 (NKJV)

No one has seen God at any time. If we love one another, God abides in us, and His love has been perfected in us. As a result of this love perfected in us over time, we gain "confidence for the day of judgment.

I John 4:12 (NKJV)

Cast Out Fear – Fear in the Greek (phobos), signified flight. It denotes that which causes flight; hence, fear, terror, dread, the fear of reverence toward God.

Nevertheless you would not go up, but rebelled against the command of the LORD your God; and you complained in your tents, and said, 'Because the LORD hates us, He has brought us out of the land of Egypt to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us. Where can we go up? 1. What Kind of Love Is This?

The Spirit of This Love

I Corinthians 13:4-9,13 (NKJV)

Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away. For we know in part and we prophesy in part.

And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.

The Security of This Love Romans 8:38-39 (NKJV)

For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

2. What Kind of Fear Is This? Four Kinds Of Fear:

1. Deep Concern for The Spiritual Welfare Of Others 2 Corinthians 11:3 (NKJV)

But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.

2. Respect Shown for One in an Authoritative Role

Ephesians 5:33 (NKJV)

Nevertheless let each one of you in particular so love his own wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.

Ephesians 5:33 (NKJV)

Bondservants, be obedient to those who are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in sincerity of heart, as to Christ;

Ephesians 6:5 (NKJV)

3. Godly Fear Ecclesiastes 12:13 (NKJV)

Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, for this is man's all.

4. The Painful Terror of Anticipated Punishment Hebrews 10:27 (NKJV)

But a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries.
