Fear is "An unpleasant emotion caused by the anticipation or awareness of danger."





The Relationship Between Faith and Fear

"I am inwardly fashioned for faith, not for fear. Fear is not my native land; faith is. I am so made that worry and anxiety are sand in the machinery of life; faith is the oil. Two Causes for Fear:



1. GUILTY CONSCIENCE

Hebrews 9:13-14
