Scripture Lesson:
Hebrews 4: 14- 16 (KNJV)



Seeing then that we have a great, High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast *our* confession. For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all *points* tempted as *we are*, yet without sin. The Throne of Grace

Hebrews 4:16, Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.



**Seven Crown Jewels We
Possess At The Throne Of
Grace.**



1. At the Throne of Grace, We Possess Access to God's Power.



Ephesians 1:19-20, The exceeding greatness of His power to usward who believe, according to the working of His mighty power, which He wrought in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead, and set Him at His own right hand in the heavenly places"



**Christ has an ability that
knows no inability.**



**The Throne of Grace is a
throne of well-timed help.
God's grace will not come
too early or too late.**



2. At the Throne of Grace, We Possess Steadfastness of Confession.



Hebrews 10:22-24, Let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds.



**We hold most tightly what
we value most highly.**



Since then, we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. (Hebrews 4:14)



3. At the Throne of Grace, We Possess Sympathy with Weakness.



Hebrews 4:14-15, Let us hold fast our confession. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.



4. At the Throne of Grace, We Possess Sinless Temptation.



**Temptation is the invitation that
can lead to sin.**



5. At the Throne of Grace, We Possess Courage Toward God.



Ephesians 3:12, In whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him.

Ephesians 2:13, But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

James 4:18, Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you.”

**Boldness is not arrogance; it is
total trust.**



**“Let us come boldly,” more
literally “with liberty of
speech.”**



Ephesians 3:14-17, For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love...

“Grace means that all of your mistakes now serve a purpose instead of serving shame.”



**6. At the Throne of Grace, We
Possess Willingness to
Receive Mercy.**



**Mercy is not receiving what I do
deserve. Grace is receiving
what I do not deserve.**



**Psalm 86:1-5, Bow down Your ear, O LORD,
hear me; For I *am* poor and needy. Preserve
my life, for I *am* holy; You are my God; Save
Your servant who trusts in You! Be merciful
to me, O Lord, For I cry to You all day long.
Rejoice the soul of Your servant, For to You,
O Lord, I lift my soul. For You, Lord, *are*
good, and ready to forgive, and abundant in
mercy to all those who call upon You.**

**What we have been given freely
should be given away freely.**



7. At the Throne of Grace, We Possess Seasonable Supply.



**John 1:16, And from His fullness
we have all received, grace upon
grace.**



Lamentations 3:21-23, “The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.”



**James 4:6, He gives more
grace!**
