**Micah 6:8, He has shown you, O man, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.**

**Amos 3:3, Can two walk together unless they are agreed?**

**Jeremiah 6:16, Thus says the LORD, stand by the ways and see and ask for the ancient paths, where the good way is and walk in it; and you shall find rest for you souls. But they said, “We will not walk in it.”**



# **What Does It Mean To Walk With God?**

**“With”** conveys a close, intimate walk with God. A walk where one has a close and personal relationship with God. **The image of walking with God conveys a closeness, a familiarity, an intimacy that is life altering.**



**Revelation 3:4, They will walk  
with Me in white, for they are  
worthy.**




# **ENOCH, NOAH, and ABRAHAM**



# 1. ENOCH'S WALK



- a) Enoch “walked with God three hundred years” (Genesis 5:22).**
- b) He was taken to heaven without experiencing physical death.**
- c) God took him” (Genesis 5:24)**
- d) The father of the oldest man who ever lived (Gen.5:21).**
- e) Enoch was a family man.**
- f) Enoch was justified by faith (Hebrews 10:38).**
- g) Enoch prophesied (Jude 14).**



**Genesis 5:24, Enoch  
walked with God; and he  
was not, for God took him.**


# **“Enoch walked with God.”**

- 1. He made spiritual progress one step at a time.**
- 2. He sought God’s way and walked in it.**
- 3. He was totally committed to the will of God.**

## **Two Observations:**

**1. Enoch Was A Great Example To His Children. His Walk Was:**

- a. A long walk**
- b. A consistent walk**
- c. A well-pleasing walk**



**Hebrew 11:6, Without faith it is impossible to please him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him”**

**2. Enoch proves that there  
is life beyond this life.**

**John 14:2-3**

**John 14:2-3, In My Father's house are many dwelling places; if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you. If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also.**



**Life is not measured in  
length, but in breadth  
and depth.**





## **2. NOAH'S WALK**


**Genesis 6:6-9**, The Lord regretted that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart. Then the Lord said, “I will wipe off the face of the earth: man, whom I created, together with the animals, creatures that crawl, and birds of the sky, for I regret that I made them.” Noah, however, found favor in the eyes of the Lord. These are the family records of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless among his contemporaries; Noah walked with God.



**Noah walked with God, not  
because he merited the privilege,  
but God extended him unmerited  
grace.**

## **Four Characteristics of Noah:**

- 1. He was Righteous.**
- 2. He was Obedient.**
- 3. He was Patient.**
- 4. He was Faithful.**



**Genesis 7:1, Enter the ark, you  
and your family; for you alone, I  
have seen you to be righteous  
before Me in this time.**

**Even the godliest people have weaknesses and can fall prey to temptation and sin.**



# **3. ABRAHAM'S WALK**



**Genesis 12:1-4, Now the Lord had said to Abram: "Get out of your country, from your family and from your father's house to a land that I will show you. I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; And you shall be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed." So, Abram departed as the Lord had spoken to him, and Lot went with him. And Abram was seventy-five years old when he departed from Haran.**
