Ministry takes work when properly supplied. The more excellent the ministry, the more work required to maintain the excellence.

Character and Lifestyle Safeguards:

I. Be A Worshipper of God

Psalms 147:1, Praise ye the Lord: for it is good to sing praises unto our God for it is pleasant, and praise is comely (it is right!).

II. Be Quick to Forgive

Hebrews 12:14-15, “Try to stay out of all quarrels and seek to live a clean and holy life, for one who is not holy will not see the Lord. Look after each other so that not one of you will fail to find God's best blessings. Watch out that no bitterness takes root among you, for as it springs up it causes deep trouble, hurting many in their spiritual lives.”

III. Don't Skip Church

Hebrews 10:25, Let us not neglect our church meetings, as some people do, but encourage and warn each other, especially now that the day of his coming back again is drawing near.

IV. Don't Have a Critical Spirit

Romans 2:1-4 (MSG), Those people are on a dark spiral downward. But if you think that leaves you on the high ground where you can point your finger at others, think again. Every time you criticize someone, you condemn yourself. It takes one to know one. Judgmental criticism of others is a well-known way of escaping detection in your own crimes and misdemeanors.

But God isn't so easily diverted. He sees right through all such smoke screens and holds you to what you've done. You didn't think, did you, that just by pointing your finger at others you would distract God from seeing all your misdoings and from coming down on you hard? Or did you think that because he's such a nice God, he'd let you off the hook? Better think this one through from the beginning. God is kind, but he's not soft. In kindness he takes us firmly by the hand and leads us into a radical life-change.

V. Learn To Be a Soul Winner

Proverbs 11:30, The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and he who wins souls is wise.

VI. Develop Regular Prayer and Study Habits

II Timothy 2:15, Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

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Eight Ways to Establish Daily Lordship in Your Life

1. Start each day with heart-felt prayer unto God asking for His anointing, wisdom, and favor.

Psalm 118:24 (KJV), “This is the day, which the Lord hath made: We will rejoice and be glad in it.”

2. Release in your heart, by faith, that good things are coming your way each day.

Psalm 62:5, Let all that I am wait quietly before God, for my hope is in him.

3. Declare your steps to be ordered by the Lord.

**Psalm 37:23, The steps of a good man are
ordered by the Lord, And He delights in his
way.**

**4. Vow to walk in love, joy,
unity, and peace with yourself
and with others.**

**Romans 14:19, Therefore let us pursue the
things which make for peace and the things by
which one may edify another.**

5. Build, review, and expand your personal rhema word lifestyle.

John 6:63, It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.

6. Each day, activate and exercise your personal faith through the avenues of dreams, visions, plans, projects, confession, and vows.

II Corinthians 4:13, And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, “I believed and therefore I spoke,” we also believe and therefore speak,

**7. Witness to someone,
sometime, in some way, each
day.**

**Romans 1:16, For I am not ashamed of the gospel
of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for
everyone who believes, for the Jew first and for
the Greek.**

8. Declare your life to be a life of joy, happiness, goodness, and thankfulness.

Psalm 144:15, Happy are the people who are in such a state; Happy are the people whose God is the LORD!

VII. Choose Your Friends Carefully

**II Corinthians 6:14, Don't be teamed with those who do not love the Lord, for what do the people of God have in common with the people of sin?
How can light live with darkness?**

VIII. Abstain from All Appearances of Evil

I Thessalonians 5:22-23, Abstain from every form of evil. Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

IX. Don't Gossip

Leviticus 19:16, You shall not go about as a talebearer among your people; nor shall you take a stand against the life of your neighbor: I am the Lord.

10. Be Careful in Your Relationships with the Opposite Sex

Ephesians 5:2-5, And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering, and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma. But fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it not even be named among you, as is fitting for saints; neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor coarse jesting, which are not fitting, but rather giving of thanks. For this you know that no fornicator, unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God.
