bringeth him before great
men.**

**The more you use
your gift, the bigger it
gets.**

**“We must seek to ask God
where we fit in and where He
would have us serve.”**

**A calling is simply a tug on
our hearts by God toward a
particular thing.**

**Romans 1:1, Paul, a servant of
Jesus Christ, called to be
an apostle, separated unto the
gospel of God.**

**I Corinthians 1:1, Paul, called to
be an apostle of Jesus
Christ through the will of God...**

Ephesians 2:10, For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

A Calling from God Will:

- 1. Never Contradict Scripture**
- 2. Always be Accompanied by His Peace and Provision**
- 3. Often be Accompanied by Confirmation**
- 4. Always Result in Him being Glorified**

II Thessalonians 1:11-12, Therefore we also pray always for you that our God would count you worthy of this calling and fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness and the work of faith with power, that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.
