**The Eye is Used to Avoid
Danger.**



The Eye is Used for Social Interaction (Relationships).



**The Eye is Used to Compensate
the Loss of the other Senses.**



The Eye is Complex.


Matthew 6:22-23, The lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light. But if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in you is darkness, how great is that darkness!

Your eyes are windows into your body. If you open your eyes wide in wonder and belief, your body fills up with light. If you live squinty eyed in greed and distrust, your body is a musty cellar. If you pull the blinds on your windows, what a dark life you will have! (MSG)

Hebrews 12:1-2, Let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that so easily trips us up. And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us. We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith.

John 3:19, This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil.

I Corinthians 2:14, The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit.

1 John 1:6-8, If we say we have fellowship with Him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light as He is the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus who cleanses us from all sin.

Judges 21:25, In those days there was no king in Israel; everyone did what was right in his own eyes.

**Psalm 19:6, The statutes of
the LORD are right,
rejoicing the heart; The
commandment of the LORD
is pure, enlightening the
eyes.**



**Do not trust your physical
eyes alone – they may lead
you astray.**

1 John 2:16, For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.



**Remember – just as our eyes
need to be on the Lord –
God's eyes are on you.**

Psalm 121, I will lift my eyes to the hills— From whence comes my help? My help comes from the LORD, who made heaven and earth. He will not allow your foot to be moved; He who keeps you will not slumber. Behold, He who keeps Israel Shall neither slumber nor sleep.

The LORD is your keeper; The LORD is your shade at your right hand. The sun shall not strike you by day, Nor the moon by night. The LORD shall preserve you from all evil; He shall preserve your soul. The LORD shall preserve your going out and coming in from this time forth, and even forevermore.
