Psalm 40:3, He put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God. Many will see and fear and put their trust in the LORD.

I. The Two Elements of Worship

A. Celebration: The Vertical Dimension

"While too many Christians" neglect to serve God with the mind, others cultivate only their minds and neglect the emotional aspects of worship."

B. Proclamation: The Horizontal Dimension

Psalm 34:1-3, I will bless the Lord at all times: His praise shall continually be in my mouth. My soul shall make her boast in the Lord: the humble shall hear thereof and be glad. O magnify the Lord with me and let us exalt His name together.

II. The Two Products of Worship

A. Spiritually Lost People are Drawn to Christ Through Worship.

"If a church was on fire for God, people for miles would come to watch it burn."

B. Spiritually Saved People are Sent Out to Share Christ After Worship.

Isaiah 6:1-8, I saw the Lord seated on a high and lofty throne, and His robe filled the temple . . . my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of Hosts. Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying: Who should I send? Who will go for Us? I said: "Here I am. Send me." (Isa. 6:1, 5, 8).

III. The Two Challenges for The Worshipper
