1. Our Salvation is  
Significant because it  
Gives Glory to God.

“Glory to God in the Highest”



**Glory** is the Greek word **dóxa**,  
which means "praise, recognition,  
honor, worship"—the height of  
reverence and adulation that we  
could give or say to God.

**Isaiah 43:7** “Everyone who is called by My name, whom I have created for My glory, whom I formed and made.”

**Psalm 19:1**, The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork.

**Psalm 8:1**, O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens.

**Psalm 150:6**, Let everything that has breath praise the LORD! Praise the LORD!
