




Amos 3:3, Can two people walk together without agreeing on the direction?




To be “equally yoked” means to be in a relationship where both individuals share the same Biblical beliefs, values, and spiritual goals.

Five Areas Christians Should Strive To Be Equally Yoked

**1. We should strive to be
equally yoked in
MARRIAGE.**

**“To marry unequally is
to suffer equally.”**



2. We should strive to be equally yoked in DATING/COURTSHIP.

Romans 12:9-10, Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good. Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor.

“Stop looking for loopholes and accept what the bible clearly stated. Do not be unequally yoked with an unbeliever. Pray for them and be a light to them, but you cannot date them into the kingdom.”

WORK.**

**Colossians 3:23, Whatever you do,
work at it with all your heart, as
working for the Lord, not for human
masters.**

**4. We should strive to be
equally yoked in Our
Place of WORSHIP.**

**5. We should strive to be
equally yoked in
FRIENDSHIPS.**
