Have Big Impact.**


**“Be more concerned with your character than your reputation, because your character is what you really are, while your reputation is merely what others think you are.”**

**INTEGRITY is not about being perfect; it's about being whole, undivided, and truthful in all areas of life, whether anyone else sees it or not.**







# **1. Examine Your Heart.**




**Psalm 26:2, Test me,
