Genesis 19:15-17, As morning dawned, the angels urged Lot, saying, “Get Up! Take your wife and your two daughters who are here, lest you be swept away in the punishment of the city.” But he lingered. So, the men seized him and his wife and his two daughters by the hand, the Lord being merciful to him, and they brought him out and set him outside the city. And as they brought them out, one said, “Escape for your life. Do not look back or stop anywhere in the valley. Escape to the hills, lest you be swept away.”

You'll never drift into spiritual maturity. It takes daily, focused effort. To become what no one else is becoming, you must do what no one is doing.

Genesis 19:16, The angels seized his hand and the hands of his wife and two daughters and rushed them to safety outside the city, for the LORD was merciful.

Genesis 19:29, But God had listened to Abraham's request and kept Lot safe, removing him from the disaster that engulfed the cities on the plain.

this place, for the LORD is about to
