In God We Trust

Foundation Scripture

Proverbs 3:5-6

Proverbs 3:5-6, Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths.

“When you can’t trace His hand, trust His heart.”

Romans 15:13, May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

How I perceive God's character will ultimately determine my level of trust in Him.

Lesson One
GOD CAN BE TRUSTED

Three Characteristics of Trusting in God:

1. A CONSTANT TRUST

"Trust in Him at all times..."

Psalm 62:5, My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from Him.

2. A COMPLETE TRUST

"...you people, pour out your heart before Him..."

Psalm 139:23–24, Search me, O God, and know my heart; try me, and know my thoughts: And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

Reference Scripture

Jeremiah 17:5-8

Jeremiah 17:5-8, Thus says the Lord: “Cursed is the man who trusts in man, And makes flesh his strength, whose heart departs from the Lord. ” For he shall be like a shrub in the desert, and shall not see when good comes, but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, In a salt land which is not inhabited. “Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, and whose hope is the Lord. For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, which spreads out its roots by the river, and will not fear when heat comes; But its leaf will be green and will not be anxious in the year of drought, nor will cease from yielding fruit.

3. A CONFIDENT TRUST

"...God is a refuge for us. Selah."

**Psalm 61:2, From the end of the earth will I cry
unto thee, when my heart is overwhelmed: Lead
me to the rock that is higher than I.**

Psalm 91:1-2, He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in Him will I trust.

Psalm 37:7, Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for Him.
