# Seven Principles About God Our Source:

**1. God's is the  
Ultimate Owner of  
Everything.**

**2. God's Provision  
is Boundless.**

**Psalm 50:10 , “Indeed, every  
animal of the forest is Mine,  
even the cattle on a  
thousand hills.,,**

**Psalm 16:2, I say to the LORD,  
"You are My Lord; all the  
good things I have come  
from You."**

# **3. Distinguish Between the Source and Channels.**

**Luke 6:38, Give, and it will be given to you. They will pour into your lap a good measure—pressed down, shaken together, and running over. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return.**

**"MEASURE" is the quality and amount of your giving that determines the quality and amount of what you receive in return.**

**THE "TWO-WAY FLOW" is the more you give out, the more God can pour in. Blessings are designed to circulate rather than be hoarded.**

**4. We Must Shift  
from Worry to Faith.**


**Matthew 6:33, But first and most importantly seek (aim at, strive after) His kingdom and His righteousness [His way of doing and being right—the attitude and character of God], and all these things will be given to you also.**

**5. We Must Trust In  
God's Promise.**

**Philippians 4:19, And my God will supply every need of yours according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.**

**“Unmet desires keep me on my knees  
and make me ransack the Bible for  
God’s promises.”**

**6. We Must Learn to  
Live by Faith, Not  
Fear.**

**7. A Percentage of  
Our Source Belongs  
to God.**



**Leviticus 27:30, “Every tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land or of the fruit of the trees, is the Lord's; it is holy to the Lord.**



# **Six Observations about Tithing:**



**A. The Biblical PERCENTAGE  
in Scripture is 10%  
(The tenth part).**



**B. Returning the tithe is  
important in *ALIGNING*  
your life with God's Word.**



**C. Giving 10% to God or more shows that our HEART isn't tied to our money and that we love God more than money.**



**D. Tithing is not a RULE. It's  
the result of a heart change.  
It should be given “out of love  
for God, not guilt.”**



**E. If we WITHHOLD our finances from God, we are rebelling against what He wants in our lives.**



**F. Many Christians see 10%  
as an insurmountable  
OBSTACLE.**



**1 Corinthians 16:2, On every  
Lord's Day each of you should  
put aside something from  
what you have earned during  
the week and use it for this  
offering.**



**If we are giving with the  
intention of only receiving  
then our hearts are not in the
